<b>Our Complaints Procedure</b>	
	<p>If you have any concerns about the way in which your matter is being conducted please raise it in the first instance with the Case Handler dealing with your file.</p> <p>If they are unable to deal with your concern to your satisfaction, you may then ask that the matter be formally investigated under our Complaints Procedure.</p>
<b>Stage 1</b>	<p>If your concern has not been addressed to your satisfaction by the Case Handler then please write or email their Supervisor who will conduct an independent investigation of the complaint. You will find the Supervisor's details in your initial paperwork or through your Case Handler. If you are unable to locate this information please email <a href="mailto:info@olaleslie.com">info@olaleslie.com</a>. Your complaint will be allocated to one of our Partners. Your complaint will be acknowledged within 5 working days and a written response will be provided within 8 weeks of the complaint being acknowledged.</p>
<b>Stage 2</b>	<p>If the complaint remains unresolved, it will at your request be escalated to our Managing Partner Ola Kupoluyi who is our Designated Complaints Handling Partner. The complaint will be reviewed and further investigations may be carried out, if deemed necessary. We will write to you within 8 weeks of receiving your request for review and confirm our final position on your complaint and explain our reasons.</p>

	<p>We have sixteen weeks to consider your complaint. Following our final response, you may have the right to Legal Ombudsman if your complaint is not resolved to your satisfaction. The Legal Ombudsman cannot deal with all complaints and will only deal with complaints from members of the public, certain very small businesses, charities, clubs and trusts. The Legal</p>
	<p>Ombudsman will tell you whether they are able to deal with your complaint.</p>
<p>If we are unable to meet any of the timescales given to you we will let you know and explain why.</p> <p>You will not be charged for our work investigating a complaint made by you.</p> <p>If because of a special need, you require us to deal with your complaint or communicate with you in a particular way please let us know so that in as far as is practicable, this may be accommodated.</p>
